- Charter is offering free Spectrum broadband and Wi-Fi access for 60-days to households with K-12/college students who do not already have a Spectrum Broadband subscription at any service level up to 100 Mbps. To enroll please call 1-844-488-8395. Installation fees will be waived for new student households.

HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS WITH AVAILABLE TESTING KITS (please call prior)

There are limited quantities available, please call ahead if you are experiencing symptoms or have been close to someone with Coronavirus. If you are insured, call your regular physician prior to going in to avoid overloading the resources for uninsured people.

Los Angeles County passed a temporary ban on all residential and commercial evictions, effective March 4 to May 31, 2020, for the unincorporated areas of the County. The City of Los Angeles and other cities have passed similar measures. These protections apply to all tenants, regardless of their immigration status. PRICE GOUGING

It is illegal for sellers to raise prices for basic necessities by more than 10% after authorities declared an emergency. All consumers, including undocumented immigrants, are protected against price gouging. Report violations to DCBA: 800-593-8222, dcba.lacounty.gov.

DMV NFWS

Seniors and other drivers can avoid required office visits for renewal during COVID-19 pandemic. Seniors with an expiring driver license will receive a 120-day extension in the mail during the pandemic. Also, those with safe driving records whose last DMV visit was 15 years ago will not be required to renew in person for the next 60 days and will be able to renew online or by mail.
