Career Fellows Program 2024

Thank you for being interested in MLK Community Healthcare's Career Fellows Program. This annual program is a 7-week health related high school internship and mentorship program that provides ten students in the community of South LA a meaningful experience by expanding their knowledge to a variety of careers in healthcare. When can I apply?

All applications open from March 13, 2024 – April 12, 2024.

Who can apply?

Current High school students in grades 10th – 12th who are enrolled in a high school located in South LA.

Is this a paid internship?

Yes! All students will be receiving a stipend for completing the program.

When does the program start?

This 7-week program runs from June 24, 2024 to August 8, 2024.

Can I apply if I am a rising sophomore in high school?

Students must be a sophomore, junior, or senior by the time the application deadline closes. We encourage you to apply next year!

Can I apply if I am a senior who will be graduating?

Yes, but please keep in mind your summer commitments. This is an in-person internship for 7 weeks in the summer.

What is the schedule for participants?

Monday-Thursday from 9am - 3pm (sometimes 4pm).
